Notice is hereby given that the resolution set out below are proposed for approval by the Members of The KCP Limited (“the Company”) by means of Postal Ballot, only by remote e-voting process (“e-voting”) being provided by the Company to all its Members to cast their votes electronically, pursuant to Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 (“the Act”), Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (“the Rules”) and other applicable provisions of the Act and the Rules read with General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020 and 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, other relevant circulars, including General Circular No. 09/2023 dated September 25, 2023 and General Circular No.09/2024 Dated September 19, 2024, issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (“MCA Circulars”), Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“Listing Regulations”), Secretarial Standard on General Meetings (“SS-2”) issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India and other applicable laws, rules and regulations (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force and as amended from time to time).

The Statement, pursuant to the provisions of Section 102(1) and other applicable provisions of the Act read with the Rules, setting out all material facts relating to the resolutions mentioned in this Postal Ballot Notice and additional information as required under the Listing Regulations is also attached.

The Board has appointed Sri. Balu Sridhar (FCS 5869 and CP No. 3550), or failing him Sri. Pankaj Mehta (ACS 29407 and CP No. 10598), partners A.K. Jain & Associates, Practicing Company Secretaries Chennai to act as the Scrutinizer, to scrutinize the e-voting process and to conduct the Postal Ballot in a fair and transparent manner. They have communicated their willingness to be appointed and will be available for the said purpose.

The Company has engaged the services of National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) for the purpose of providing e-voting facility to all its members, pursuant to Section 108 of the Act read with Rule 20 of the Rules, as amended, and Regulation 44 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and aforementioned MCA Circulars.

Special Resolution for appointment of Dr. Janaki Pillai as Independent Woman Director of the company for the Second term of 5 (Five) consecutive years.

“RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the provisions of Sections 149, 152 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 (“the Act”) read with Schedule IV to the Act (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force) and the Companies (Appointment and Qualification of Directors) Rules, 2014, as amended from time to time, and pursuant to the recommendation of the Nomination & Remuneration Committee and the Board of Directors, Dr. Janaki Pillai (DIN: 08713712) aged 65 years, who has submitted a declaration that she meets the criteria for independence as provided under Section 149(6) of the Act and Regulation 16(1) (b) and Regulation 17 of the Securities Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, be and is hereby appointed as Independent Woman Director of the Company, not liable to retire by rotation, for a second term of five consecutive years commencing from 28th February, 2025.

1. The explanatory statement pursuant to Section 102 read with Section 110 of the Act stating all material facts and the reason/ rationale for the proposal is annexed herewith.
2. This Postal Ballot Notice is being sent to the members whose names appear on the register of members / list of beneficial owners as received from the National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL") and Central Depository Services (India) Limited ("CDSL") and whose email address is registered with the Company / depository participant(s), as on **Friday 28th February, 2025** ("Cut-off Date"). A person who is not a member as on the Cut-off Date should treat this Postal Ballot Notice for informational purposes only.

In compliance with Regulation 44 of the LODR Regulations and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 108 and 110 of the Act read with the rules framed thereunder and the MCA Circulars, the manner of voting on the proposed resolution is restricted only to e-voting i.e., by casting votes electronically instead of submitting postal ballot forms. Accordingly, physical copy of the Notice along with Postal Ballot Form and pre-paid business reply envelope are not being sent to the Members for this Postal Ballot. The communication of the assent or dissent of the Members would only take place through the e-voting system.

3. The resolution, if passed by the requisite majority through Postal Ballot, will be deemed to have been passed on the last date specified for voting i.e., **Monday, 07th April, 2025**.

Further, resolutions passed by the members through postal ballot are deemed to have been passed as if they are passed at a General Meeting of the Members.

4. The Scrutinizer will submit their report to the Chairperson & Managing Director or any other person authorized by her after the completion of scrutiny of the e-voting, and the result of the e-voting by Postal Ballot will be announced not later than 48 hours from the conclusion of e-voting and will also be displayed on the Company website **<https://www.kcp.co.in>**, on the website of NSDL **www.evoting.nsdl.com**, and communicated to the stock exchanges.
5. All material documents referred to in the explanatory statement will be available for inspection online at the Company website **<https://www.kcp.co.in>** from the date of dispatch of notice until the last date for receipt of votes by e-voting. - a) In compliance with Regulation 44 of the Listing Regulations and Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Rule 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended and the relevant MCA Circulars, the Company is pleased to provide facility of e-voting to enable its Members to cast their votes electronically in respect of the resolutions as set out in this Postal Ballot Notice.

How to cast your vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system?

1. After successful login at Step 1, you will be able to see all the companies “EVEN” in which you are holding shares and whose voting cycle is in active status.
2. Select “EVEN” of company for which you wish to cast your vote during the remote e-Voting period.
3. Now you are ready for e-Voting as the Voting page opens.
4. Cast your vote by selecting appropriate options i.e. assent or dissent, verify/modify the number of shares for which you wish to cast your vote and click on “Submit” and also “Confirm” when prompted.
5. Upon confirmation, the message “Vote cast successfully” will be displayed.
6. You can also take the printout of the votes cast by you by clicking on the print option on the confirmation page.
7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

General guidelines for e-voting

1. Institutional shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) are required to send a scanned copy (PDF / JPG format) of the relevant Board resolution / authorization letter etc. with attested specimen signature of the duly authorized signatory(ies) who are authorized to vote, to the Scrutinizer by e-mail to akjainassociates@gmail.com with a copy marked to evoting@nsdl.co.in.

Institutional shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) can also upload their Board Resolution / Power of Attorney / Authority Letter etc. by clicking on “Upload Board Resolution / Authority Letter” displayed under “e-Voting” tab in their login.

2. It is strongly recommended that you do not share your password with any other person and take utmost care to keep your password confidential.

Login to the e-voting website will be disabled upon five unsuccessful attempts to key in the correct password. In such an event, you will need to go through the “Forgot User Details / Password?” or “Physical User Reset Password?” option available on www.evoting.nsdl.com to reset the password.

The Board of Directors of the Company based on the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee, had approved the appointment of Dr. Janaki Pillai (DIN:08713712) as Independent Woman Director of the Company, not liable to retire by rotation, for a second term of five consecutive years commencing from 28th February, 2025 in terms of Regulation 17 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements), Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations"), Sections 149, 150, 152, Schedule IV and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Act read with the Companies (Appointment and Qualification of Directors) Rules, 2014 (including any statutory modification(s) and/or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force).

Dr. Janaki Pillai is not disqualified from being appointed as a Director in terms of Section 164 of the Act and has consented to act as Independent Director of the Company. The Company has also received declaration from Smt. Janaki Pillai that she meets the criteria of independence as prescribed under Section 149 read with Schedule IV to the Act and the Listing Regulations.

The Company has received a notice in writing from a Member pursuant to Section 160 of the Act, proposing the candidature of Dr. Janaki Pillai for the office of Director of the Company, to be appointed as such under the provisions of Section 149 of the Act.

In the opinion of the Board, Dr. Janaki Pillai fulfils the conditions for appointment as an Independent Director as specified in the Act and Listing Regulations and is independent of the Management.

Smt. Janaki Pillai worked as a College Lecturer and as a development Professional. She has a continuing interest in development of education and is also an English Language Trainer. She worked as Lecturer in Department of Sociology at Stella Marris College, Chennai.

She is a Member of CSR and Stakeholders Relationship Committees of the Company.

Her shareholding in the Company is NIL.
